- 5 game items = t-shirt

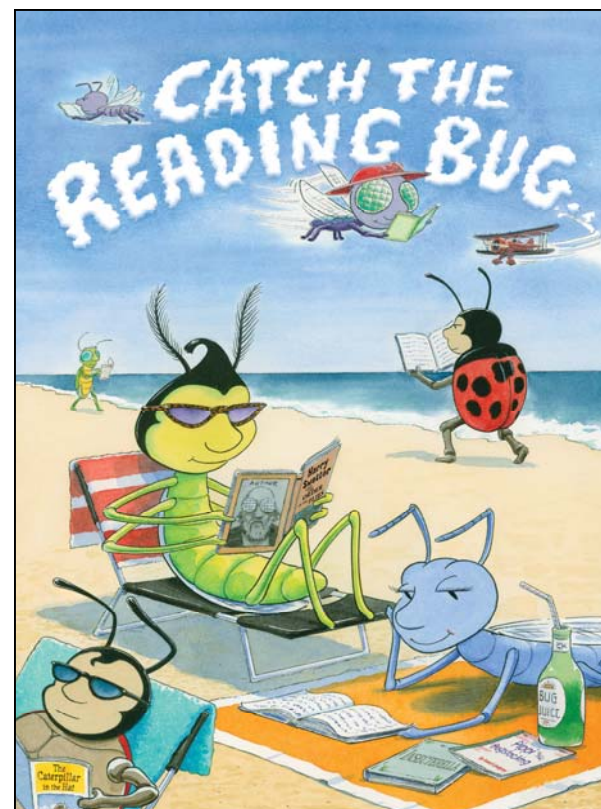
High School - Adult ~ *Book Bingo*

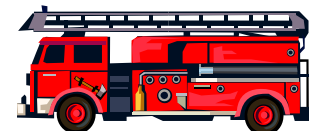
